



Method of Evaluating Scholarship Applications for the 2016-2017 ACEC-Los Angeles County Chapter Scholarship Program

ACEC Los Angeles County Chapter Scholarship Applications are scored against the following five criteria:

I. Cumulative Grade Point Average

Total GPA and Major GPA

II. Recommendations

Two recommendations are needed from an engineering professor, a consulting engineer, or a land surveyor. Use the enclosed form – a letter is not sufficient.

III. Essay

Essays must be typed or neatly printed. Points may be deducted for poor grammar, incorrect spelling, illegibility, or lack of neatness. Proofread carefully.

IV. Work Experience

List your more recent work experience first and include any jobs held during high school. Indicate the year in school during which you held the particular position. Describe your duties in the position, including level of responsibility and staff supervised, if any. Indicate if your work experience was in the form of work-study, co-op, or practicum. Clearly identify the nature of the business of the listed employers; in particular, note consulting engineering or land surveying firms. Be complete and accurate. Use additional sheets if necessary to fully describe work experience.

V. Extracurricular Activities (College)

- Student organizations
- Community activities
- Organized athletics and/or musical activities
- Other

Describe your involvement in activities, including any offices held in any organization. Be as complete as possible. If there are no activities, write "none".
